Recruiter’s Corner:

“Active First” provides potential recruits the ability to go active duty for 30 months to four years, and upon expiration of this first term they can opt to enter the National Guard or stay on active duty.

Being able to recruit for the active component opens up a new group of G-RAP targets that you can get paid for. See SSG Crane or SFC Fain for details.

G-RAP Status:

Currently this company has only 18% of our G-RAP Assistants listed as “Active” – which means that you’re not processing your leads through the G-RAP system. AND that means you won’t get paid. Follow up on your leads! Our goal is to get 50% of our assistants working the system!
